The Adirondack Research Consortium is pleased to announce the **2021 Richard D. Morse Memorial Award Fund**. Through the Fund, an annual **\$500 award** is presented to a student who is studying at a college/university in the region that shares the passion Rick had for **environmental policy, music, and/or outdoor activities**. The funds are to be used to support research or educational activities.

To be eligible, students must be admitted in good standing, and enrolled in a program related to environmental science, policy, music, and/or outdoor activities. The Consortium will accept nominations from each invited college/university which states the student's qualifications and commitment to these areas of study and interest. To apply, please send a one-page letter of nomination from a faculty member, along with, a one-page letter from the student demonstrating award criteria and stating how the funds would be used to support academic pursuits. **Nominations will be accepted until noon on Friday, April 15th, 2021.**

The Award will be made directly to the student and presented at the virtual **Awards Program on May 5th, 2021 at 5:00 via Zoom**. This is a one-time award, with application for future awards welcome. Our expectation is to continue this annual award until the funds have been fully utilized.
