



## 2023 Richard D. Morse Memorial Award

The Adirondack Research Consortium is delighted to present the 2023 Richard D. Morse Memorial Award Fund. This **annual \$500 award** is given to a student from a college/university in the region who shares Rick's enthusiasm for environmental policy, music, and outdoor activities. The money is used to finance research or educational activities.

To be considered for eligibility, students must be in good standing and enrolled in a program related to environmental science and have interests in music and outdoor activities. Faculty representatives may submit nominations for students with a short statement detailing their qualifications until **12pm on Friday, May 5th, 2023**.

The Award will be made directly to the student and presented at the Awards Luncheon during the 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference on the Adirondacks on **May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023** at the Conference Center in Lake Placid. This is a one-time award, with application for future awards welcome. Our expectation is to continue this annual award until the funds have been fully utilized.
