This is an invitation to submit an abstract for a **paper** to be presented at the Conference. Individuals may also choose to submit an abstract for a **poster** to be displayed throughout the proceedings which will include an opportunity to meet other conference attendees to discuss it. If your paper is not accepted, you are invited to present a poster.

Due to the limited presentation times on the Conference program, the Consortium will be accepting a limited number of papers for presentation. The Consortium is encouraging poster presentations which will be displayed throughout the Conference and celebrated at a “Meet the Author” session.

The 2016 Annual Conference theme is **“Connectivity in the Adirondacks and the Northern Forest.** The Consortium welcomes research on these and other topics including the humanities, social sciences, and community development. Presenters will each have 15-minutes for presentation and audience discussion.

Decisions on paper presentations will be made no later than March 31, 2017. If a paper is not selected for presentation the author is invited to present a poster.
